Who can join U3A?

Anyone over 50, with an interest in shared life-long learning activities

Do you need a degree to join?

No – the term 'University' is used in a general sense of shared learning.

Do you have to take exams?

No – it's about keeping your mind active and enjoying the company of like-minded people.

Is it expensive?

No – Annual subscription is only \$40. Other course costs are at the discretion of the Course Coordinator and kept to a minimum.

Are there other activities?

We encourage members with special interests or knowledge to pass on that knowledge through presentations. External guest speakers are also invited. Other special interest groups are organised by members.
