

CO-ORDINATES: SET 2

You will need to refer to the grid provided with the Week 3 games for this exercise.

Using the “Where are we?” grid draw the symbols (letters, numbers, etc.) represented by the co-ordinates given in each question. In some cases you can draw a continuous line through the points identified by co-ordinates, e.g. the letter Z. In other cases you will need to draw more than one, e.g. the letter A. The number of lines will be shown in the question, as well as the type of resulting symbol. Note that in some cases the continuous line may cross over the line that has already been drawn.

1. 5,2: 5,11: 9,3: 13,11: 13,2 (1 line, letter)

2. 6,2: 6,11: 12,2: 12,11 (1 line, letter)

3. 5,2: 8,12: 11,2: Line 2: 6,5: 10,5 (2 lines, letter)

4. 13,8: 7,8: 11,13: 11,5 (1 line, cross over, number)

5. 6,15: 12,15: 6,8: 12,8 (1 line, letter)

6. 7,14: 10,10: 10,6: Line2: 10,10: 12,14(2 lines, letter)

List co-ordinates to represent:
