Classic Travel Writing - Book discussion course

A selection of classic travel writers, from the letters of Lady Mary Montagu from Constantinople in the 1700s, to the multiple layers of history and intrigue described by literary visitors to Rome from across the centuries. There will be an anthology from Patrick "Paddy" Leigh Fermor, considered by many as the greatest travel writer of the twentieth century: tales from his sleeping in barns and grand country houses across Europe in the 1930s, to his love affair with the Greek landscape and people. Consideration of what motivated such travel writers to leave the comforts and securities of home and set forth on voyages of discovery and adventure.
